WHEREAS, the citizens of Iowa understand the essential role that education regarding the topic of Water Safety plays in preventing drownings and recreational water-related injuries; and

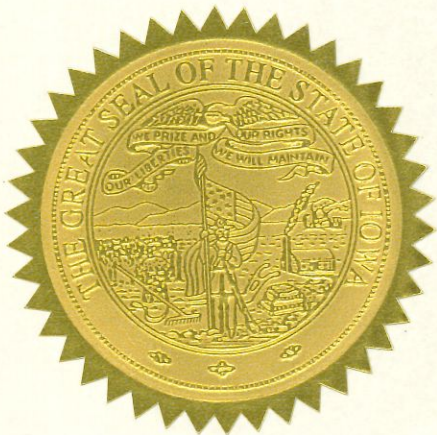



NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kim Reynolds, the Governor of the State of Iowa, do hereby proclaim May, 2026 as:


